

Per section 220 of the National Bylaws, "Vacancies and Removal of Elected Officers or Committee Members" states that "Any elected Post officer or committee member removed, by reason of failure to pay current dues or under the provisions of this section shall not be eligible to serve in any Post office or committee in the same administrative year in which the officer or committee member is removed."

Action will be taken as necessary to those who continue to violate and insist on sitting in Auxiliary meetings. Post members can attend Auxiliary meetings IF INVITED and FOR A PURPOSE. Post members cannot just show up and attend Auxiliary meetings. We work together, but we are separate! Posts stay out of Auxiliary Business, Keep Auxiliary out of Post Business and Work together for the VFW organization.

- 12. Youth Program Reminder, continue getting students, scouts, and schools involved in the Essay programs. Let them know the VOD, Patriot Pen, and Youth Essays are due to the Posts on October 31.
- 13. Continue to work on Post Audits, all Posts that were missing audits, the audits must be up to date by October 15 to comply with the National Bylaws.
- 14. Remember to keep your Post and District Commanders informed of ongoing actions and activity. We can't help and mentor if we don't know what is needed.
- 15. Read up on the new National Bylaw Changes, take the time to look up the correct answer to questions and problems and to find out how to do things and what right looks like. There were many changes made at last year's convention to the National Bylaws.

## 16. Definitions of Dress Codes are as follows:

Business Casual defined as: (for men) shirt with collar, slacks with or without sports jacket; (for women) slacks, skirt, or casual dress. No jeans, denim, shorts, or athletic type footwear.

**VFW Casual** defined as: VFW apparel with slacks or skirt. No jeans, denim, shorts, or athletic type footwear.

**Business** defined as: (for men) Suit and tie; (for women) Slacks, skirt, or dress with (optional) jacket.

Formal defined as: (for men) a tuxedo; (for women) an evening gown or very smart cocktail dress

**Semi Formal** defined as: (for men) a suit with vest optional or coat and tie, either bow or straight, and shirt should be simple button down; (for women) a dress, dressy pantsuit, or dress suit.
